- 2) Statement of purpose (via online application) 1-2 pages, describe why you are pursuing graduate school; elaborate your research experience(s) including background, hypotheses, experimental approaches, real or expected results, and implications; lastly discuss your future career aspirations.
- 3) Three letters of recommendation (via online application) - must include your research mentor
- 4) Official transcripts upload instructions - <https://utexas.app.box.com/s/r0cr58md52shujnwz3zupmdg30ahcx29>
- 5) *The neuroscience graduate program is NOT requiring GRE scores for fall 2025 applications.*
- 6) Official TOEFL/ IELTS scores (International Students only)
- 7) Application fee
